Message from Summer@Galloway

Here at Galloway, we recognize that this has been no ordinary year. As we look to the summer of 2021, we feel confident that we can make a face to face camp experience happen. In order to do that we have made a number of changes to ensure we can run a safe and effective program. Changes in place for 2021 mirror much of what we did during this school year:

- Programming will be designed so students are in contact with no more than 20 people (campers and staff) during their camp week.
- We'll be utilizing Galloway's largest interior spaces to allow appropriate social distancing and spending as much time outdoors as possible.
- Lunch and snacks will be brought from home and eaten outside with social distancing enforced.
- Cleaning protocols are in place for cleaning classroom spaces and equipment between activity groups. Where appropriate, program kits will be provided to campers to avoid the sharing of supplies.
- Expect lots of hand washing and hand sanitizer. A decision about Covid testing, vaccination, and mask use will be made as we assess the needs and options for our campers closer to the summer, but as of today, we are planning for a masked summer.
- Health checks will be done at check-in each day. Students and staff will not be allowed to participate if they are feeling ill. Recognizing that we are all a little nervous about camp next summer, we have modified our cancellation policy to make it easier for you to feel comfortable planning for camp and making changes as necessary. We are providing 100% refunds up until May 1, 2021 and 50% from May 1 – May 15, 2021.

We will continue to identify strategies to keep our campers healthy in the evolving situation and plan to update parents as we move into the spring. Know that we are drawing on the best information available from the CDC, Georgia Department of Health and the American Camps Association.
